We are a modern, relevant multi-racial school that embraces all that is best in South Africa's ever-changing environment. At Maritzburg College, we are immensely proud of our shared identity that binds the present to the past beneath a vivid tapestry guilted in Red, Black and White.

Our Maritzburg College Foundation is a registered Non-Profit Organisation (NPO) mandated to provide College with strategic and financial support. Your support can not only assist the school but also add to your B-BBEE scorecard.

The Foundation can also issue Section 18A certificates for tax saving purposes on any donations.

The two main areas of B-BBEE focus for College are Skills Development and Socio Economic Development:

- 1. **Skills Development:** This element allows for payment of bursaries to Black South African Students, who must be either grade 10 or above. In supporting Maritzburg College, you can earn B-BBEE points on your scorecard under this element.
- 2. **Socio Economic Development:** There are no age restrictions in supporting scholars in this category.

SKILLS DEVELOPMENT

Supporting a previously disadvantaged learner through spend on tuition, scholarships or bursaries, which is 3.5% of payroll (Leviable Amount), a company can score 6 points out of 20 points. A spend on bursaries or scholarship which is 2.5% of payroll (Leviable Amount) on Black learners at Higher Education Institutions, basic educations schools or colleges, can score 4 points out of 20 points.

SOCIO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT (SED):

In terms of the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice, the objective of this element is to promote sustainable access for beneficiaries to the economy. SED contributions are monetary or non-monetary contributions implemented for individuals (natural individual or group of natural individuals) or communities, where at least 75% of the beneficiaries are classified as black people, in terms of race and are of any age group.

As a proudly multi-racial school, Maritzburg College's current demographics are 51% African/black learners. As an option, any bursaries paid to a Black/Indian/Coloured South African individual/student can be used towards this element, this can be any grade and 100% of the contribution would count


A full table of the levels of B-BBEE points accumulation is shown below:
