THE FOUNDATION CAMPAIGNS


The causes supported by the Foundation are closely aligned to the long-term strategy of the school.

SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Creating opportunities for promising boys from all walks of life to experience the rich traditions and life-shaping education that our school offers, is a strategic imperative.

DIRECT SCHOLARSHIP FUNDING

Dependent on personal preference and/or the potential tax or CSI benefits, the opportunity exists to donate directly towards a scholarship or bursary. Donors can elect to allocate funds to either Academic, Sporting and/or Cultural scholarship options.

ENDOWMENT FUNDING

In order to provide for meaningful and long-term bursaries and scholarships, we have prioritised establishing endowment funds. This allows for contributions to continue in perpetuity.

PUPIL SUPPORT FUND

Maritzburg College is justifiably proud of the prominent sportsmen, academics, business leaders and social entrepreneurs who are among our Old Collegians, and we strive to provide a relevant, internationally competitive education, that produces young men of the very highest calibre.

ESTATES FUND

SUSTAINABILITY FUND

Recent projects include the installation of extensive solar panels and supporting infrastructure as well as the creation of more eco-friendly spaces through the planting of indigenous trees around campus. COMMUNITY OUTREACH FUND

The Fund aims to support both the local and wider College community, with a key focus on the Khanyisa programmes. Launched in 2009, the Khanyisa High School project, sponsored by Hulamin, provides learning materials, transport, lunch, and weekend classes for Grade 11 and 12 students from Pietermaritzburg. In 2022, the Khanyisa Primary Schools Programme was established, supporting Grade 6 and 7 learners with classes and sports programmes, sponsored by the Joan Anderson Educational Trust. Since its inception, Khanyisa has grown from a local programme to one with international aspirations that embraces digital resources as a tool for learning. By donating towards this worthy cause, and investing in our youth, you will help to improve the lives of all South Africans.
